CONFIRMATION CATECHISM PROGRAM

Syllabus | Year 2022-2023

CONFIRMATION YEAR I

Welcome to the Confirmation Program at St. Peter Chanel! The Confirmation Program is a two year program for youth who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Someone who has already received the Sacrament of Confirmation as a child is most welcome to participate as well. Any youth of age 13 (or has begun 8th grade) up until the age of 16 may attend. The following is a list of things that we are asking of the parents and the students.

I. WHAT ARE WE EXPECTING FROM THE STUDENTS?

Journey of Faith:

- Attend Holy Mass every Sunday.
- Frequent Confession, at least once a month.
- Daily prayers; specially the recitation of the holy rosary.
- Acts of mercy; this can be praying for someone, saying a kind word, or helping someone through some good action.
- A penance every Friday; it can be easily fulfilled by abstaining from eating meat.
- **Every student is to attend the Youth Activity once a month**, in which they will be enriched more about our Catholic faith with other teens their age. See Schedule for more information.

Classes:

- Classes will be held every **Tuesday** from **4:30PM to 5:30PM**.
- First class will begin on **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2022**.
- We ask that the students **be punctual**. We ask the parents to drop their children 10 minutes before the scheduled class time.
- **Every week the student is to bring a rosary, notebook, a pen or pencil.**
- No more than 5 absences are permitted; this includes the Tuesday Class every week and the Youth Activity once a month.
- Homework: every week the student is to answer some simple questions.
- **The students are to dress modestly and behave in a manner that is respectful of the house of God.**

II. WHAT ARE WE ASKING OF THE PARENTS?

Accompany your child in their Christian journey (*see Catechism of the Catholic Church #'s 2221-2231*):

- Active participation in the Sacraments; go to **Holy Mass every Sunday**, frequent **Confession**, at least once a month.
- Daily prayers, and help them with their journey of faith.
- **Once a MONTH parents are to accompany their child to Holy Mass during class time.** See Schedule for dates.

III. COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- All participants must adhere to the COVID-19 and Parish safety protocols.
